

Rules and Conditions of entry for The Hospice of St Francis Dame For A Laugh 2012

Once you have read the following conditions of entry, please check the box on the online registration form to agree to abide by these terms.

Conditions of Entry

I understand that running or walking along public roadways and/or in possibly uneven, wet and/or slippery conditions could be potentially hazardous. I understand that if I am in doubt about my health or have a medical condition that may be affected by exercise, I should obtain a Doctor's approval before participation in the event. I acknowledge that I participate in this event at my own risk and that The Hospice of St Francis can not be held liable for any injury, accident, loss, damage or public liability caused or sustained before, during or after the event as a result of my participation, unless caused by the negligence of the Hospice of St Francis. If under 16, I will be accompanied by a responsible adult. I understand that the registration fee purely covers the cost of the event and I will raise sponsorship for The Hospice of St Francis.

- Places are limited. Entries are processed in the order received.
- Closing date for entries, Wednesday 28th March, subject to the number of entries received.
- Each participant must fill in an application form or must register individually online. If you are taking part as a Team you are still required to fill out a separate registration form.
- All under 16's must be must register individually but must have their registration form signed or their online registration completed by a parent/guardian to show their consent for this to happen.
- When sending in either your registration form or your sponsorship money, please put your name and address on the back of your cheque, made payable to 'The Hospice of St Francis'. Do not send cash in the post.

- If you are sending in your money as a team, please nominate a team leader who is responsible for sending all team sponsorship money raised. Please attach all sponsorship forms together, along with the full amount raised and send to us as one package.
- Disabled entrants with limited mobility are welcome to take part, although due to the nature of the event, we ask you to contact the Hospice Fundraising team prior to filling in this form. If a disabled person requires assistance from another person, this person must also enter the event, but will not have to pay.
- Your registration fee covers all expenses including administration of your entry, running number, and a medal. It secures your place and is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Sensible footwear must be worn, preferably trainers and certainly not high heels.
- The consumption of alcohol immediately prior to, or during the event is not permitted.
