The Hospice of St Francis is a charity that supports and cares for people with life-limiting illnesses. We bring peace, comfort and dignity to people and help them to make the most of life, discovering what is important to them and helping to plan ahead.

Care is given at the Hospice in our beds and our new outpatient hub, the Spring Centre, or in the patient's own home. Our team also provide outreach care in local hospitals and nursing homes. We also believe support of families and carers is an essential part of our care.

The Hospice of St Francis is a registered charity receiving no more than 20% of its funding from the NHS. We therefore rely on the generosity of our local community to fund the remaining 80% of our costs. This comes from individuals, local businesses, trusts, schools, community groups, fundraising, our shops, our lottery and Gifts in Wills.

A wonderful way to remember someone special

This unique handmade sculpture, designed by local Artist Claudia Ashley-Brown, offers a wonderful way to remember someone special whose memory you hold dear. It is situated in a prime position at our Hospice and will be seen daily by all who come to visit.

Our Memory Tree is adorned with 450 autumnal coloured leaves which capture the light beautifully.

Each leaf will be engraved with the name of a loved one as a lasting tribute to their memory, and each leaf will help our hospice grow further.

Once dedicated, your leaf will be placed upon the tree, where it will remain for a year. At the end of each year, you can then either renew your leaf for a further year or we will send you your leaf in a special keepsake box.
