WHO ARE WE?

The Hospice of St Francis is a charity providing free specialist palliative care to people living with life-limiting illnesses across West Herts and South Bucks. Based in Berkhamsted, the Hospice has served the local community for over 46 years and last year we cared for 2,466 people.

It costs over £6m per year to fund our free care and with only 17% of our funding coming from the NHS, we rely on the generosity of the local community.
