

## **Complementary Therapist - Massage**

The Hospice of St Francis Charity provides essential free care across West Hertfordshire and South Buckinghamshire and inspires people to raise over £6million every single year to fund this care.

Complementary Therapy is a key service that sits within the Wellbeing Team. The postholder will deliver high quality massage/aromatherapy to patients that are referred to the Spring Centre and within our In-patient Unit. They will work alongside other members of the Complementary Therapy and Wellbeing team to support patients who may be palliative or on a curative pathway of a life-limiting illness. They will carry out assessments and manage their own caseload from referral to discharge.
